Do the players play house league?

Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA)

No

Waxers Rostered Select (RS) Yes

When are the games played?

During the week beginning at 5:00 pm— week or on the and on the weekend beginning at 12:00 pm

Either during the weekend at times scheduled by the team

RS teams can opt to participate in the York Simcoe League

Is there body checking?

How many times are you on the ice per week on average? Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA) Yes from Minor Bantam (age 13) and older

Four

- two hours of practice
- away game
- home game

Three

- house league practice and game
- RS practice and/or game

Waxers Rostered Select (RS)

No

How are coaches selected?

How are teams selected?

Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA)

Through an application and interview process

Coaches select their team through tryouts that begin in mid-April Waxers Rostered Select (RS) Through an application and interview process

Coaches select their team through tryouts that begin in late April/early May

When are teams chosen?

Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA) After tryouts by early May Waxers Rostered Select (RS) Majority of team selected after May tryouts

There may be some selections in September

Yes, players must reside in the City of Markham

Is there a residency rule?

AE players must reside in the City of Markham

A, AA, and AAA teams may include nonresident players

When do teams begin to practice?

When does the season begin?

Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA)

This depends on the coach, typically mid to late August

Exhibition games begin in August, season begins in September Waxers Rostered Select (RS) Generally in early October

Exhibition games begin in August, optional season begins in September

When does the season end?

How many tournaments do teams participate in on average? Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA)

Season play ends in January and playoffs end at the end of March

Up to 4 tournaments per season

Waxers Rostered Select (RS) Season ends at the end of March

Up to 3 tournaments per season (Novice through Midget)

May I be rostered to a Waxers AE/A/AA/AA team as an Affiliate Player (AP)? Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA)

Yes

- to the age group above (e.g. a Minor Peewee can AP to a Peewee team) or
- to a higher category (e.g. an AE player can AP to an A team)

Waxers Rostered Select (RS) Yes

- to the same age group or
 - to one age group above (e.g. a Minor Peewee can AP to a Peewee team)

What is the estimated cost per season?

Waxers Rep (AE, A, AA)

Average of \$2,000

Each team sets its own budget which varies by category (AE/A/AA/AAA) and depends on the amount of ice purchased, the number of tournaments attended and the team merchandise purchased, among other things. Parents generally have input into the budget level.

Waxers Rostered Select (RS)

Average from \$1,000 to \$1,500

House league fees (\$500) plus RS team fees, which range from \$500 to \$1,000 depending on the amount of ice purchased, the number of tournaments attended and the team merchandise purchased, among other things. Parents generally have input into the budget level.

Dance

Average of \$1130.

Two classes for two terms (\$880) plus dance costume (\$250)

For competitive dance, \$1000 per class per year plus costumes and expense for away competitions

Waxers Tyke Minor Development

- Tyke Minor Development (formerly Tyke A or Super 7) is a development program for 7-year-old players.
- Players do not play house league.
- They play a full-season schedule in the York Simcoe Minor Hockey League.



- They may participate in up to 2 tournaments per season.
- Players must reside in Markham.

Waxers Tyke Select

- Tyke RS (formerly Tyke B) is a team comprised of 7-year-old players
- They play house league and RS.
 - Team begins competing December 1st.
 - They may participate in up to 3 exhibition games per month against other Tyke Rostered Select teams and up to 2 tournaments per season.

Players must reside in Markham.



Waxers Initiation Rostered Select (RS)

- Initiation RS (formerly Tyke C) is a team comprised of 6-year-old players. 5year-old players cannot participate.
 - They play house league and RS.

- Team begins competing December 1st.
- They may participate in up to three exhibition games per month against other Initiation Rostered Select teams and up to two tournaments per season.

Players must reside in Markham.
