What to Expect For Your Rental

These measures will be implemented at all arena facilities while in Step 3 of Ontario Roadmap to reopening

General Information:



- Masks are required at all times while walking through the facility or spectating sport
- Keep a safe distance of 2 meters or 6 feet from others at all times
- Hand sanitization is encouraged upon entry
- Each group must review and follow the updated Return to Play guidelines from the appropriate governing National or Provincial Sport Organization

Available for Usage:

- Change rooms will be available
- Spectator access will be permitted
- Washrooms will be available
- Showers will be available

Facility Arrival and Screening:

- All participants are encouraged to arrive at the facility no earlier than 30 minutes prior to their on ice rental
- In order to facilitate entrance to the facilities, some entrances and exits within the buildings may be closed. Signage will be placed around the building directing participants and spectators where to go
- Prior to entering the facility, all coaches, trainers and parents must complete Markham's screening protocol

Step #2 - Show our staff at the front door your green check mark	



- Participants do not need to complete Markham’s Simple Track screening protocol, provided that the organization has completed and tracked that information themselves and is able to produce the information in the event of a COVID-19 case. Coaches must ensure participants self-assess prior to entering the facility and must track which players are present for each booking
- In the event that the organization does not have a separate COVID-19 screening protocol, participants must complete the check in process through the Simple Track application

Important Information:

- No more than 85 participants on the ice including participants, coaches, referees, etc.
- All game play or scrimmages may operate in accordance with the provincial guidelines in addition to Return to Play guidelines from the appropriate sports governing National or Provincial Sport Organization
- Masks are not required during on ice activities however must be worn to and from the change rooms, and any time outside of the field of play
- Rental groups must manage change room social distances 2 meters and masks are required. Additional change rooms will not be available
- Pre-game warm up is to be completed outside of the building until further direction from the Ontario Hockey Federation can be provided
The use of hallways, walkways, spectator stands, etc is prohibited
- Participants and spectators must leave the premises after the conclusion of their activity

Additional Recommendations:

- Dress in as much equipment as possible to limit dressing rooms usage
- Do not leave valuables unattended in the facility
- Spitting is strictly prohibited
- Bring a full water bottle, labeled with your name. (City fountains are not available). Do not share water bottles
- Do not share equipment
