U7 Programming - 4 Options

1. House League (HL)

On the ice two times per week: one skills session, one game.

2. House League with additional development training

On the ice up to three times per week: HL skill session and game, as well as one additional development session.

Day and time for additional will be finalized in fall. Additional cost for the extra development session.

3. House League and U7 Select Tier 1 Team

On the ice up to four times per week: HL skill session and game, select team practice, select game.

Preparation phase and evaluations are held in the fall. Additional costs to participate on the select team. Team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program.

4. House League and U7 Select Tier 2 Team

On the ice up to four times per week: HL skill session and game, select team practice, select game.

Preparation phase and evaluations are held in the fall. Additional costs to participate on the select team. Team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program and will be comprised of players who did not make the U7 Select Tier 1 team.



U8 Programming - 4 Options

- 1. House League (HL)
 On the ice two times per week: one skills session, one game.
- 2. House League with additional development training
 On the ice up to three times per week: HL skill session and game, as
 well as one additional development session.
 Day and time for additional will be finalized in fall. Additional cost for
 the extra development session.
- 3. House League and U8 Select Team
 On the ice up to four times per week: HL skill session and game, select team practice, select game.
 Preparation phase and evaluations are held in the fall. Additional costs to participate on the select team. Team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program.
- 4. U8 MD Team

This development team **will not** participate in HL. On the ice up to 4 or 5 times per week. Preparation phase and evaluations are held in the fall. Additional costs to participate based on the team's budget.

U9 Programming - 4 Options

1. House League (HL)

On the ice two times per week: one skills session, one game.

2. House League with additional development training

On the ice up to three times per week: HL skill session and game, as well as one additional development session.

Day and time for additional will be finalized in fall. Additional cost for the extra development session.

3. House League and U9 Select Team

On the ice up to four times per week: HL skill session and game, select team practice, select game.

Preparation phase and evaluations are held in the fall. Additional costs to participate on the select team. Team will participate in the Competitive Pathway Program.

4. U9 MD Team

This development team **will not** participate in HL.

On the ice up to 4 or 5 times per week. Preparation phase and evaluations are held in the fall. Additional costs to participate based on the team's budget.

Through an application and interview process

Coaches select their team through evaluations that begin in mid-April for U10 and older or in September for U9 and younger

Through an application and interview process

Coaches select their team through evaluations that begin in early May for U10 and older or in September for U9 and younger.

Is there a residency requirement? Must you live in Markham to participate?

BB and MD players must reside in the City of Markham No residency requirements

A, AA, and AAA teams may include non-resident players

When do teams begin to practice?	This depends on the coach, typically mid to late August	Generally in early October
When do games begin?	Late September	October

When does the season end?

Season play ends in January and playoffs end at the end of March Season ends at the end of March

How many tournaments do teams participate in on average?

Up to 4 tournaments per season

Up to 3 tournaments per season

For U9 and below, tournaments are referred to as "Jamborees"

Am I eligible to be rostered to a Waxers MD, BB, A, AA, AAA team as an Affiliate Player (AP)?

What is the estimated cost per season?

Average: \$4,500

Each team sets its own budget which depends on the amount of ice purchased, the number of tournaments attended, team apparell purchased, among other things.

Average: \$750-\$1,200

House league fees plus select team fees, which range from \$750 to \$1,200 depending on the team budget. Team parents have input into the budget.

NOTE: Select fees capped at \$1200 per player

Lake Ontario Region (LOR) Rules

- Only affects residents of Toronto, Mississauga, Vaughan, Markham, Richmond Hill, Ajax/Pickering, Oakville, and Brampton. Rules set by the Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) to allow players in the LOR to play on teams outside of their municipality of residence.
- At U10, a Markham resident player must declare where they want to play: GTHL (Markham Islanders/Majors) or OMHA (Markham Waxers).
- Players can then only play for the declared organization unless they are released.
- At U14 and older all players are free to move to other associations within the LOR.
