Player's Code of Conduct

All players registered in the Markham Minor Hockey Association are expected to adhere to the following principles.

- I will respect and adhere to all policies and rules determined by the Markham Minor Hockey Association Board.
- I will play and compete for my own enjoyment, as well as for my team.
- I will do my best to be a good sport at all times.
- I will not defend or engage in actions on or off the ice, which are not consistent with good sportsmanship.
- I will have fun, make friends, improve my skills and play safely.
- I will maintain self-control at all times.
- I will attend all games and practices. Be present before games and practices in a timely manner. Notify the coach ahead of time if you will be absent.
- I will learn, understand, and respect the rules of the game.
- I will respect the rights, feelings, and abilities and consider the safety of other players, coaches, trainers, administrators, volunteers and parents.
- I will show respect for the decisions, judgment, and authority of the officials and timekeepers.
- I will respect the facilities in which I am privileged to play.
- I will not use foul language towards teammates, coaches, officials, or opponents.
- I will accept both victory and defeat graciously.
- I will avoid drugs, tobacco and alcohol.

Should I be found to be in breach of this code of conduct, I understand that I may be subjected to a disciplinary process, by either the MMHA Board or by a disciplinary subcommittee appointed by the Board, at the absolute discretion of the MMHA Board of Directors, and subject to penalties including removal from the team and association without refund of any fees paid.
