

The Province has implemented a vaccine requirement for individuals entering recreation facilities, coming into effect September 22nd, 2021.

All Particpants, parents/guardians/spectators will be required to show proof of vaccination (second dose received at least 14 days prior to visit) or a letter stating a medical exemption each time they enter a recreation facility, with the following exemptions:

- * children under the age of 12
 * Youth under the age of 18 who are actively participating in an organized sport

Effective Nov 1st, YORK REGION WILL REQUIRE ALL PARTICIPANTS/COACHES/SPECTATORS/GAME OFFICIALS/VOLUNTEERS TO BE FULLY VACCINATED TO ENTRY ANY FACILITY.

Effective Nov 1st, OMHA REQUIRES ALL ELIGIBLE PARTICPANTS TO BE FULLY VACCINATED AS WELL.
